Staged Building Construction

Starting in 1995, our firm was retained to undertake a comprehensive, staged development project for Ag Canada. Starting with a planning and feasibility study, our firm worked to identify and understand the facility and program requirements for each portion of the research facility in order to develop an integrated and staged process for building the facility 'from the ground up'.

With the completed and approved planning in place, our firm has proceeded to implement each phase of the project over the last 10 years. These have included the completion of the Chemical Storage Building, replacing the Maintenance Workshop, and major Site Works Redevelopment to provide grading and site services for the remaining expansion. The crowning achievement was the completion of the Crop Services facility, which included administration offices, laboratories, industrial research workshops, delivery and storage areas, and staff support facilities. The Crop Services Building has allowed Agriculture and Agri-foods Canada to consolidate several of their functions into a single building, providing a state-of-the-art facility that is the envy of similar agencies across Western Canada.
